Based in Naarm (Melbourne), we aspire to educate, entertain and inspire Australians to understand the culture, heritage, and connection to Country of our First Nations people.

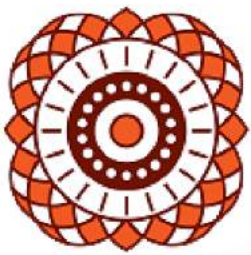

ABORIGINAL CULTURE

This resource-rich, interactive 'show-and-tell' program is a great introduction to Aboriginal culture, as it covers a range of topics.

THE EXPERIENCE

A highly engaging presentation and discussion of traditional bush food sources, hunting tools, musical instruments, arts and crafts. Authentic objects are passed to the children for that memorable, hands-on experience: animal skins, possum skin ball, emu eggs, boomerangs, emu caller, baskets and necklaces.

We demonstrate how to make traditional paint with ochre, charcoal and clay.

Activity: children play clap sticks to live didgeridoo music.

We supply:

A wide range of authentic Aboriginal artifacts and animal skins, large pull up banners with images, clap sticks for all children.

We need:

Sufficient floor space for children to sit in a semi-circle.
Name tags for the children, if possible.

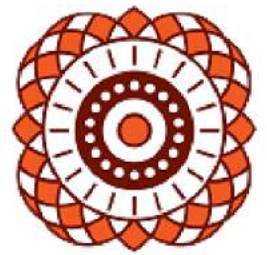

This is a great program if you want to get the children up and dancing and be part of a contemporary musical performance with traditional Aboriginal instruments!

THE EXPERIENCE

A highly interactive live music / dance experience for the children, conducted by a didgeridoo performer with over 20 years experience.

After an introduction of the didgeridoo the children will practice simple rhythms with body percussion and clap sticks while moving through the room. Simple dance moves are introduced and children are dancing to live didgeridoo music.

We are then forming a 'band' and delivering a high-energy performance - with children playing clap sticks and dancing to the sound of the didgeridoo and electronic beats.

We supply:

Clap sticks for all children, amplification for live music.

We need:

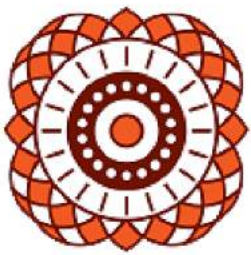
Sufficient floor space for children to dance.

Song, Dance & Storytelling

Children learn an Aboriginal and a Torres Strait Islander song, traditional dance moves and creation stories from a First Nation educator.

THE EXPERIENCE

Barama will teach children to sing an Aboriginal and a Torres Strait Islander song and explain the lyrics and what the songs are about. This is followed by learning about traditional dance where children get to practice some traditional dance moves, including imitations of certain animals.

Children learn about the world view of Aboriginal people and their deep connection to all living beings and to country through Barama's storytelling. A range of authentic cultural objects is presented during this experience as well.

We supply:

One educator, cultural objects, pull up banners.

We need:

Sufficient floor space for children to dance.

Fee:

\$495 incl. GST per 30min session

Sufficient floor space for children to dance and sit down for viewing and exploring the artifacts.

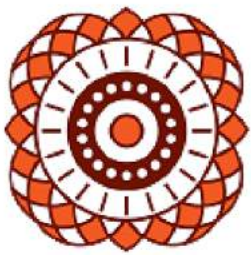

Boomerang Painting

This incursion is a fun-filled introduction to Aboriginal symbols and how to tell stories with them. Children are taught how to use Aboriginal symbols to decorate a wooden boomerang.

THE EXPERIENCE

In the absence of written languages, Aboriginal people used paintings to convey knowledge for thousands of years. Art styles vary greatly across Australia. In this incursion, children get introduced to a number of Aboriginal symbols and the art of storytelling through symbols. Children will then paint a wooden boomerang to take home at the end of the day.

We supply:

Wooden boomerangs, paint, brushes, symbol stamps, display materials illustrating Aboriginal symbols and materials for the demonstration on how to make traditional paint.

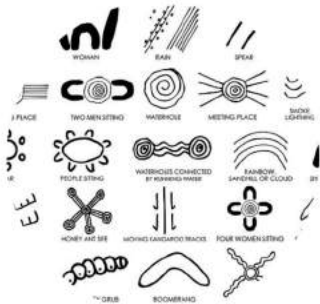
We need:

Tables and chairs set up for 4-6 children per table in a room with easy access to a sink to clean the resources afterwards.

We need:

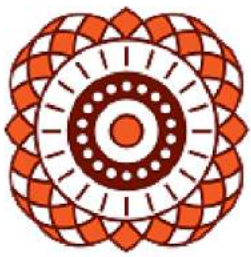

Didgeridoo & Dance Performance

This assembly concert is a great way to celebrate a special occasion by connecting the whole centre with Aboriginal community via music & dance!

THE EXPERIENCE

This assembly concert starts with setting the mood with an acknowledgement of Country, followed by Barama presenting interactive storytelling & dance, accompanied by the mystical sound of the didgeridoo as played by Ganga Giri.

Ganga will introduce the didgeridoo and gradually take the participants on a musical, tribal didgeridoo and beats dance frenzy. A great concert with plenty of audience participation - the audience enjoy learning rhythm and dance and celebrating multi-cultural Australia in the now.

We supply:

Two performers including an Aboriginal dancer and world-renown didgeridoo virtuoso Ganga Giri, amplification and microphones,

We need:

Stage area for performers and enough space for audience to dance

Fee:

\$1900 incl. GST - up to 30mins.

This program starts with setting the mood with a Welcome to Country by an Aboriginal elder, followed by interactive storytelling accompanied by the mystical sound of the didgeridoo. Once engaged, we take the children on a musical tribal didgeridoo and beats dance frenzy. The children enjoy learning rhythm and dance and celebrating multi-cultural Australia in the now.

We supply:

Two performers including an Aboriginal elder and world-renown didgeridoo virtuoso Ganga Giri, amplification and microphones.

We need:

Tables and chairs set up for 4-6 children per table in a room with easy access to a sink.

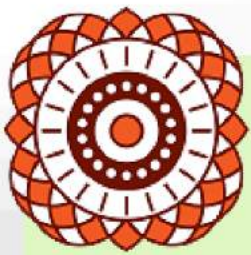

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Community Celebration

This bespoke event is an ideal way to celebrate culture with your whole community and provide several highly engaging activities through out the whole event.

THE EXPERIENCE

The event starts with a Welcome to Country performed by a local elder, followed by a smoking ceremony – a special blessing for your centre and your audience.

Up to three interactive experiences are then run simultaneously in different areas at your centre, designed for participants to join in at their leisure:

- 1) *Collaborative Art* - painting murals of Waa the crow and Bunjil the eagle
- 2) *Artifacts* - tactile exploration of a large range of authentic cultural objects
- 3) *Song and Dance* - interactive live didgeridoo music and dance performance

(*We can also arrange for a permanent mural to be created for your Centre that can be added to collaboratively by your children.)

We supply:

Up to five educators / performers, including an elder. All materials for the rotational activities. Amplification for live music. Decorative banners. Photo files to advertise the event to your audience.

We need:

Areas to set up the activities at your centre (typically one room for each activity, Song and Dance can be set up in the yard as well)

Fee:

\$5,000 - \$10,000, depending on duration and number of educators. Please contact us for a customised quote.
